

The Alabama League of Municipalities has room blocks for the 2020 Convention.

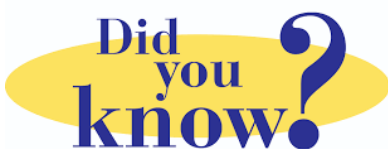
Hotel Room Blocks open on Monday, February 6, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. CST.

If you make reservations before this date and time, you **will not** be in the ALM room block, nor will you receive the discounted rates that ALM has negotiated for our Members.

Please check www.alalm.org for information and notice will be in "This Week" e-newsletter after January 15, 2020.

General Information for making reservations:

- There **WILL** be an individual name required for each room reserved.
- Limit of five (5) reservations per caller.
- There will be a one night's **NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT REQUIRED** and must be secured with a major credit card. Reservations will be cancelled if the credit card that is used to guarantee the reservation is declined or invalid when the hotel takes the non-refundable deposit.



Why doesn't ALM book entire hotels or more hotel rooms for the convention? *We use historical data to contract the amount of rooms needed for the convention. In most hotel contracts, when a group doesn't live up to the room-block commitment, a payment is required to make up for the rooms not rented, according to the terms of the attrition clause in the contract.*

What is an attrition clause? An attrition clause in a contract is a commitment to pay for a specific number of rooms and should your number decrease, this reduction of numbers may require a payment as a penalty. The penalty payment is billed to ALM and not passed on to our Members. So it is crucial to use the rooms in the room blocks set up by ALM.
