Below is a list of public benefits commonly provided by local governments in Alabama that appear to be subject to SAVE verification under Alabama law. If your locality provides any of these benefits, please check the appropriate box and provide to the SAVE program. If the applicants for the benefits identified below are the only individuals who will be subject to verification with SAVE, the SAVE program will not generally require your municipality to provide additional legal authority to approve the application. If you will use SAVE for verification of other benefits not on this list, you must provide the relevant legal authority, as explained in the **SAVE Program Registration Checklist**, for those individual benefits to be approved by the SAVE program.

CONTRACTS:

- Generally.** Municipalities are generally authorized to contract based on their corporate identity and authority under §11-40-1, Code of Alabama 1975.
- Franchises.** Municipalities are authorized to enter into and grant franchises as provided in Section 220 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901. A franchise is a form of contract or agreement granting a person or business the special privilege of using streets, roads and rights of way.

BUSINESS/OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES:

- Generally.** Municipalities are authorized to license businesses as provided in Article 2 of Chapter 51 of Title 11, Code of Alabama 1975.
- Waste Grease Handlers** – In addition to the provisions Article 2 of Chapter 51 of Title 11, Code of Alabama 1975, municipalities have authority to license waste grease handlers as provided in §11-40-23, Code of Alabama 1975.
- Alcoholic Beverages** – In addition to the provisions of Article 2 of Chapter 51 of Title 11, Code of Alabama 1975, municipalities are authorized to license the sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages within their jurisdiction as provided in Chapter 3A of Title 28, Code of Alabama 1975.
- Motor Carriers** – In addition to the provisions of Article 2 of Chapter 51 of Title 11, Code of Alabama 1975, municipalities are authorized to license motor carriers as provided in §37-3-33, Code of Alabama 1975.

MISCELLANEOUS BENEFITS:

- Utility Assistance through CDBG program**
- Public Housing through Housing Authorities** - Articles 2 and 4 of Chapter 1 of Title 24, Code of Alabama 1975, provide for the creation of Municipal Housing Authorities and/or Regional/Consolidated Housing Authorities who have broad authority to deal with and provide affordable housing and to provide for the costs of operation and maintenance of housing.
