Please note that some events scheduled during the Conference are held by outside groups and are not affiliated with the League or the Conference. Based on the conclusions in Ethics Advisory Opinion 2011-01 and an informal opinion the League has received from the Ethics Commission, attendees at the League Conference should exercise caution before accepting an invitation to dinner, etc. from a vendor that is not a registered participant in the Conference. While the opinion indicates that a non-registered vendor or company who desires to interact with attendees during the conference may provide meals and other food and beverages, they may not under any circumstances use the interaction as an opportunity to lobby attendees or otherwise use it for sales opportunity. League events are listed in the official program, website or on the app. If you have questions regarding whether an event is part of the Conference or is affiliated with the League, please contact the League directly.
